Biking along the blond Tiber to Fiumicino !!

Enjoy your bike tour and a good "spaghetto alle vongole"

Meeting point : h. 8.15 Viale Aventino 8 (Opposite side to FAO) - Start: h. 8.30

We will meet outside the FAO and cycle along the banks of the Tiber to Fiumicino, crossing the Regina Ciclarum... We will take a break to enjoy some mixed fried seafood or a "spaghetto alle vongole" (spaghetti with clams) in Fiumicino. A beautiful route along the Tiber, free of traffic, will take us through the Roman countryside to the sea at Fiumicino. Return by train from Parco Leonardo or by your own means.

- Length: about 35 km
- Difficulty: Technical difficulty: 2; physical difficulty: 3; (* see difficulty scale below) (the route is mostly flat and does not present particular difficulties; it takes place first on asphalt, then along the river bank on a compact dirt road);
- Required to know how to ride on roads open to vehicular traffic;
- Ability to cycle for many hours required.
- Suitable bikes: mountain bike gravel bike, hybrid bike, , e-bike, city bike
- **HELMET OBLIGATORY**
- Front and rear bike lights are recommended (mainly just in case you prefer go back home by bike)

**difficulty scale: 1 very easy; 2 easy; 3 moderately demanding; 4 quite demanding ; 5 very demanding*
