Crepe Paper Flower Workshop

This crepe paper flower workshop will teach you how to make simple flowers such as carnations, lavender, poppies and anemones.

The classes consist of preparing the stem with pistil that will make up the flower, the cardboard guide for the petal, the type of crepe paper to use, which will be provided during the course, how to make the sepals, and the technique for creating the flower.

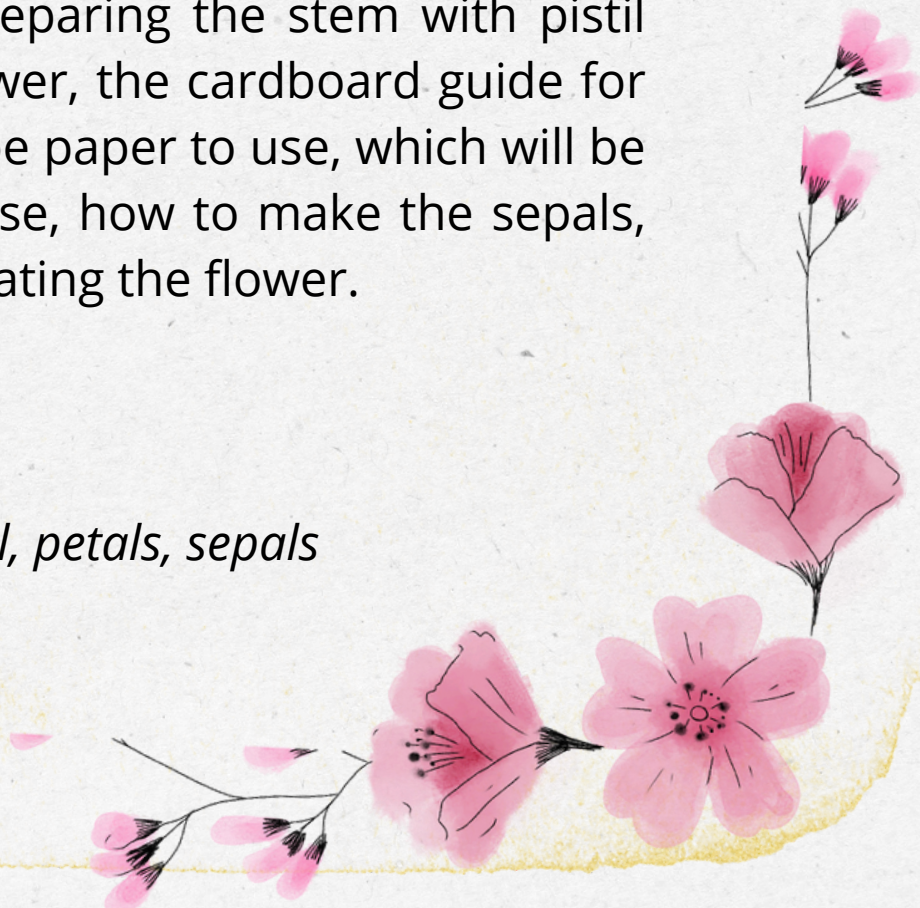
Materials provided:

Stem

Crepe paper for: stem, pistil, petals, sepals

Glue

Cardboard guide
