





# Weekend 25-26 October 2025 Parco della Maremma (GR) Tuscany

(train + bike mode)



<u>Meeting point</u>: Rome, Saturday 25 October directly on the train to Grosseto that will be communicated to participants a few days in advance;

Return from Albinia: 26 October 2025: many trains available.

We will arrive in Grosseto on Saturday morning and head towards Alberese. After a few kilometers, we will be able to admire the beautiful Maremma Park, arriving in Alberese where we will stay. On Sunday, we will cross the Maremma Park for many kilometers with the possibility of reaching the remains of an ancient abbey, then we will reach Talamone to conclude our tour in Albinia, from where we will take the train to Rome.

- Length: day 1 about 40 Km ascent about 250 mt; day 2 about 40-50 km ascent about 350-500 mt
- Physical difficulty: **day 1** easy (level 2); **day 2** easy-moderately demanding (level 2-3) \* see the scale below
- Technical difficulty: **day 1** easy (level 2); **day 2** easy-moderately demanding (level 2-3) \* see the difficulty scale below
- Bottom: secondary asphalted regular roads and stretches of dirt roads
- Ability to ride on roads open to car traffic is required
- Suitable bicycle: mountain bike gravel bike, hybrid bike e-bike
- HELMET OBLIGATORY

<sup>\*</sup>difficulty scale: 1 very easy; 2 easy; 3 moderately demanding; 4 quite demanding; 5 very demanding

#### **NOTES:**

- Front and rear bike light recommended (to go home from Rome rail station).
- Two stages itinerary with overnight stay and luggage in tow.
- We recommend bringing as little luggage as possible, as well as a bicycle with a rack and panniers. If you are using a backpack, make sure it is as small as possible (max. 15-20 liters).
- spare inner tube or tire repair kit recommended.

cycling trousers with pad, windstopper / rain jacket Glasses (sunglasses), gloves
