The San Gregorio estate stretches over the Chianti Colli Senesi hills around Chiusi, in the southern part of the province of Siena. Lands, these, prodigal of generous wines since time immemorial, lands where wine is an integral part of a millenary tradition and culture. In this luxuriant context, for generations, the passion for viticulture has been the secret of genuine wines of undeniable quality. The estate covers about 120 hectares, 19 of which are vineyards, and until the 1950s the San Gregorio winery made viticulture its vocation, and since 1987 it has been marketing and developing the company brand, producing authentic Chianti Colli Senesi wines that are identified with the territory. The philosophy is based on the enhancement of Tuscan culture, cultivating only vines that have evolved and adapted over time in this area. In addition to producing wine, San Gregorio is also an agritourism and breeding of Cinta Senese (a breed of domestic pig from the province of Siena, in Tuscany).

Renovation

One building was converted into a wine cellar, retaining only the perimeter walls and the beautiful arches of the room that was used as a stable at the time. The other construction instead preserves the original structure intact: an unusual structure in the Tuscan countryside. It is a very regular and modular construction, quite different from the typical farmhouse, and perhaps used as accommodation for seasonal workers (while the farmhouse housed the sharecropper family).

Origins

News of the San Gregorio estate dates back to the 18th century, in fact it appears in a manuscript of the Curia Vescovile di Montepulciano that it was owned by a convent of nuns from Chiusi.

Since the 1950s, the San Gregorio estate has made viticulture its vocation, and in 1987 the marketing and development of the estate's brand began.

Agritourism

San Gregorio is located in Chiusi, a suggestive village with historical Etruscan origins, immersed in the luxuriant Valdichiana countryside. We have six comfortable flats (Casina, Pina, Poldo, Lola, Lino, Stella), located in the heart of the farm and surrounded by olive trees and rows of Sangiovese vines, surrounded by arable fields and woods, a natural lake and a phytodepurated swimming pool, immersed in a centuries-old wood.



Breeding of Cinta Senese

Since the early 2000s, we have focused this activity on the breeding of Cinta Senese pigs, delimiting vast plots of woodland and arable land with appropriate fencing, providing the most suitable crops for the pigs' natural feed in the field.

Breeding: semi-wild, leaving the pigs free to graze in the fields and woods.

High quality: Our herd currently consists of animals that are all selected and registered with both the Cinta Senese DOP (Denomination of Protected Origin) consortium and the INQ (Index of Nutritional Quality) for quality control plans.





The cultivation of the vines destined to produce a Chianti like ours is subject to strict regulations aimed at protecting the quality characteristics of the product.

In the San Gregorio vineyards, every single vine receives the careful care that only old farming techniques can provide:

pruning, tying, hoeing, cleaning are manual;

and the grape picker selects for each type of grape the best bunches that will go to the cellar for separate vinification. The grape varieties on the farm are: Sangiovese, Canaiolo, Ciliegiole, Colorino, Barbera, Malvasia and Grechetto.


