Can I insure my foreign-registered vehicle in Italy?

Yes. Coverage is available for non-EU/EEC registered vehicles for up to 135 days with proof of Italian residency. After this period, the vehicle must be registered with an Italian license plate for coverage to continue.

Can I drive outside of Italy with my Italian car insurance?

Yes. Travel within the EU, Schengen Area, and the UK is included with our Third-Party Liability coverage, with a Green Card provided.

Do I need an Italian driver's license or international permit?

No. As long as you hold a valid driving license, we can offer Italian car insurance. An international driver's permit is recommended for driving in Italy and must be obtained before arrival.
