



Sunday, 5th June 2022 Biking beyond Rome (Valdevarri) !!

enjoy your bike tour in authentic and wild nature (train + bike mode)



Meeting point : 7.00 hrs Roma Tiburtina Rail station (at the platform of the train Regionale n. 4560, departure at 7.10, arrive at 9,03 at Tagliacozzo)

Return from Tagliacozzo : hrs 14.06 to Rm Termini; 16.48 to Rm Termini; 18.52 to Rm Tiburtina; 21.24 to Rm Termini. Bike ticket required

One day bike tour on the borders between Lazio and Abruzzo in uncountaminated and wild nature. We will take the train to go to Tagliacozzo (AQ); from Tagliacozzo rail station we will reach the beginning of the tour in 5 km.

Just few steps from Rome, in the wild and uncontaminated nature, we will pass through ancient villages where time seems to stand still. Tour of Monte Sant'Angelo, between Lazio and Abruzzo, on dirt and asphalted roads almost without vehicular traffic. At the end of the we will return to Tagliacozzo rail station to come back home by train.

- Lenght : 55 km ca (+ 5 km from Tagliacozzo rail station to the starting point of the track)
- Gradient: 1100 mt
- Difficulty: quite difficult
- We will ride dirt roads and few stretches on the regular roads.
- Quite difficult bike tour; you will need to be used to ride for many hours a day and an good level of training is necessary.
- Experience in riding on roads open to veichle traffic is required.
- Suitable bicycle: mountain bike, hybrid bike, gravel bike.
- HELMET OBLIGATORY
