A 20% discount will be dedicated to FAO Staff Coop members for olive oil purchase in the mill.

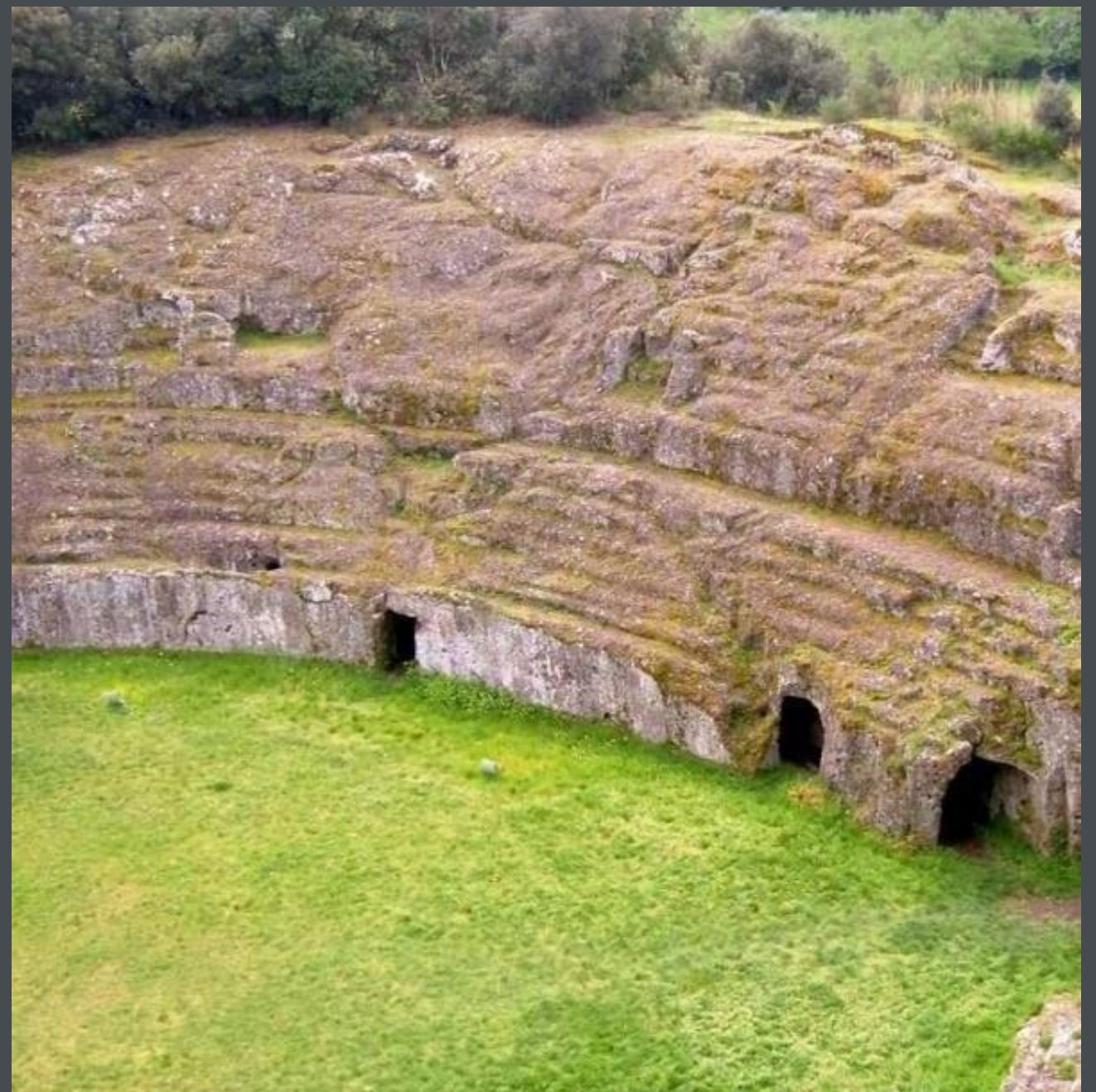
The tour will be confirmed when a minimum of 10 adults sign up.
