- Various approaches to the Vision: observation and elaboration of the subject from several levels of perception
- <u>Study of the right media to represent the subject:</u> oil painting/acrylic painting/pencils and markers/photography/decoupage/mixed media
- Realization of the entire artwork, including the support to "frame" it or "present" it.
