NOTRE DAME DE PARIS – Milan Ballet

For the first time in Rome, a creation by Stéphen Delattre for a new production of the Balletto di Milano: a danced version of Notre-Dame de Paris inspired by the famous novel by Victor Hugo. Paris, 1482. Quasimodo - the hunchbacked bell-ringer of the cathedral - falls madly in love with the beautiful gypsy girl Esmeralda. Frollo, the Archdeacon of the Cathedral, is also fascinated by the beautiful gypsy. And it is from this love triangle that passion, love, religion, but also sin, jealousy, possession are triggered: a drama of great emotions that is translated here into a powerful, expressive dance. Every movement, every variation recounts the complexity of the human soul grappling with conflicting instincts in a succession of intense scenes that enhance the skill of the young soloists and the corps de ballet.
