





Saturday 20th January 2024 Ancient Appian way and Castel Gandolfo Lake bike tour

(round trip by bike or return by train)





Meeting point: FAO - Viale Aventino, h. 8:45, start 9:00

The Appia Antica, the largest open-air museum and the lake of Castel Gandolfo, ... a beautiful tour through history, to reaching the lake of Castel Gandolfo and to tasting the typical foods of the Roman castles.

We will start our tour from FAO and we will ride the Via Appia, up to Lake Castel Gandolfo, crossing secondary roads and olive groves in the last stretch. We will be able to taste a porchetta sandwich, overlooking the lake. If you prefer, you can return by train by your own (many trains available).

- Length: about 22 km (+ 22Km)
- Difficulty: easy
- Bottom: secondary asphalted regular roads and some stretches of dirt roads and typical ancient slabs of Appia Antica.
- It is required the ability to ride on roads open to vehicular traffic;
- Suitable bike: mountain bike, hybrid bike gravel bike,
- HELMET OBLIGATORY
