Meeting point : on the train Regionale n. 12784 - departure from Roma Ostiense at h. 7:45 to Manziana-Canale Monterano (h. 9:04); **you can choose the most suitable departure station by consulting** <u>www.trenitalia.it</u>. **Return by train from Manziana-Canale Monterano :** several options until 19.00

Tour through the Canale Monterano Nature Reserve, the woods of the Agricultural University and the Mignone valley. The striking ruins of ancient Monterano, which was abandoned in 1780 following devastation by French troops, are worth a visit.

Tour details:

- Length: Km 30
- Ascent: about 800 mt
- Difficulty: quite demanding
- It is required the ability to ride on roads open to vehicular traffic;
- Suitable bike: mountain bike, hybrid bike gravel bike,
- HELMET OBLIGATORY
