



# **30 March-01 April 2024**

Tagliacozzo - Roccasecca - Sperlonga (train + bike mode)

Bicycle trip with overnight stay and luggage in tow

Enjoy a bike tour from Abruzzo to Sperlonga beach through "Valle Roveto" and "Gole del Melfa"



Meeting point: Roma Tiburtina rail station on Saturday 30 March at 7:00hrs a.m. at the platform of the train Regionale n. 4568, departure to Tagliacozzo at 7:15hrs, (arrival at 9.26hrs).

**Return** from Fondi on 1<sup>st</sup> April: many opportunities from 15:00 until about 21:00

## Due to limited places, advance booking is required

We will cross the Apennines through the "Valle Roveto" and "Valle di Comino", mostly downhill route (except on the third day), and many interesting villages to Sperlonga, a beautiful town on the Tyrrhenian Coast.

Possibility of short detours to visit "Zompo Lo Schioppo" waterfalls and Pastena caves.

Bicycle trip with overnight stay and luggage in tow.

- Total Length (in three days): about Km 160 / Total ascent: about mt. 1200
- Difficulty: quite easy
- Bottom: secondary asphalted regular roads and some stretches of easy dirt roads
- Ability to bike for many hours and a good level of fitness are required
- Ability to ride on roads open to car traffic is required
- Suitable bicycle: gravel bike, road bike, hybrid bike, mountain bike, e-bike
- HELMET OBLIGATORY

## **Program:**

**Day 1**: We will reach Tagliacozzo by train and we will start our tour to Sperlonga; first night at Carpello (Posta Fibreno Lake) - accommodation in B&B "La casa sul Lago" and "La finestra sul lago"

Day 2: from Carpello to Lenola - Accommodation at the "Collecammino B&B"

Day 3: from Lenola to Sperlonga and Fondi. Train to Rome from Fondi

#### **NOTES:**

- Front and rear bike light recommended (to go home from Termini station).
- Itinerary in three stages with overnight stay and luggage in tow.
- It is recommended carrying as little luggage as possible; bike with luggage rack and side bags; if using backpack on shoulders as small as possible (max 15-20 lt)
- Spare inner tube or tire repair kit recommended.

### **Recommended clothing:**

cycling trousers with pad, windstopper / rain jacket Glasses (sunglasses), gloves (bathing suit and towel for the lake)

#### Bike and e-bike rental on demand:

Bike and helmet provided and picked up by the guide €. 60.00 per person for three days;

Accommodation: double room €. 35,00 per person; single room €. 50,00 per person; breakfast included.

B&B La Finestra sul Lago - Carpello Lago di Posta Fibreno (FR)

Accommodation: double room €. 50,00; triple room €. 60,00: suite for 5 people €. 90,00 (possible double room); breakfast included.

## **2nd night** B&B Collecammino Lenola (FR)

Accommodation: in bungalow €. 50,00 per person in multiple room (possible double room);

breakfast included

(single room – if available- €. 90,00 per person)

The price includes: two overnight in B&B, breakfast and fee for the Guide.

Not included: train tickets, lunches, dinners, bike rent and extras.

Limited places in the hotel; it is recommended booking as soon as possible !!! Very limited possibilities of single rooms in B&B.

*The tour will take place with a minimum of 3 people;* 

The tour may be canceled in case of bad weather or impediment of the Guide

The route can be modified if necessary, at the sole discretion of the Guide.
