Another three-year project continues in May: one related to Czech composer Leoš Janáček, which has already featured *Kát'a Kabanová* and "*Da una casa di morti*", and concludes with *Jenůfa*. All three titles are produced in collaboration with the Royal Opera House in London. *Jenůfa*, scheduled May 2-9, marks the Rome Opera debut of the great German director Claus Guth, who won the Olivier Award in 2022 for best opera production with this very show. Conducting it is Juraj Valcuha, a highly regarded interpreter of Janáček's music and current music director of the Houston Symphony Orchestra, who makes his debut at the Costanzi theatre. The cast includes the great Karita Mattila in the part of the sexton Buryjovka. Orchestra, Chorus and Corps de Ballet of the Teatro dell'Opera di Roma. New production by the Teatro dell'Opera di Roma in co-production with the Royal Opera House Covent Garden in London.
