By bike along the blond Tiber to Fiumicino!! Enjoy your bike tour and a good "spaghetto alle vongole"

Meeting point: 8:45 hrs - Metro Station, Viale Aventino 8 (opposite FAO) Start: 9:00 hrs

We will meet outside FAO, and cycle along the bank of the Tiber up to Fiumicino, crossing the Regina Ciclarum....; Just a break to taste a fried fish or a "spaghetto alle vongole" in Fiumicino. Beautiful journey along the blond Tiber, devoid of traffic that allows us to reach the sea of Fiumicino through the Roman countryside.

Return by bike (along the same route) or by train from Parco Leonardo on your own.

- Length about 35 km (+35 in case of return by bike).
- Difficulty: moderately demanding; the route is flat and does not present particular difficulties; it takes place first on asphalt, then along the river bank on a compact dirt road; required to know how to ride on roads open to vehicular traffic; ability to cycle for many hours required.
- HELMET OBLIGATORY
- Front and rear bike lights are recommended (mainly for returning home by bike)

Price: €20.00 per person to be paid directly at meeting point. A €5.00 special discount will be applied to those who bring other people (relatives or friends), which will be applied to them. Special price for family group minimum 4 people: €. 12.50 for person.
