Exactly five years after the death of the great Maestro Ennio Morricone, the Federazione Cori Italiani FEDERCORI - Chorus Inside, in collaboration with Chorus Inside Lazio APS, is organising a great tribute-concert to celebrate his musical genius in one of the most prestigious venues in the capital: the Auditorium della Conciliazione. Over 130 choristers from some of the most representative choral groups on the Roman scene will perform on stage: Cantores in Laetitia, Jubilus Ensemble, Per Vocem Ensemble, Grande Coro di Roma, Muzio Clementi, Note Controvento, Via Montello, Virgo Fidelis and 7 Hills. Alongside them, a formidable symphony orchestra of about 50 elements: the Xylon Orchestra, conducted by Maestro Paolo Matteucci, a figure of great experience and national prominence in the world of choral and orchestral conducting. The audience will be taken on an emotional journey through the most famous soundtracks composed by Ennio Morricone: from Once Upon a Time in America to Giù la testa, from Nuovo Cinema Paradiso to The Mission, including Il segreto del Sahara, Moses and many other unforgettable gems that have marked the history of world cinema.
