PHOTOGRAPHY BASICS with Matilde Damele

During the 10 classes course we go through the key elements of technical photography; from Shutter Speed to Aperture, Exposure, Composition, Digital Formats and Sequencing of photographs.

We also practice outside what we learnt in class and we review the images together the following week.

By the end of the course the students will have knowledge of: How to use the light and expose the camera correctly The different use of lenses Good composition and sequencing Creative exposure and shutter speed Shooting in low light How to read an image and create a sequence of 3 or more images The basics of postproduction
